RESIDENCE

Catholic Charities' **Glenwood Residence** offers 80 units of permanent housing to late-stage, chronic alcoholics. Glenwood Residence works to both reduce costs of care and provide a safe environment for chronic alcoholics. Many low-income, homeless, chronic alcoholics struggle to attain sobriety. Glenwood Residence serves chronic alcoholics in Hennepin County who have had repeated admissions to detoxification centers and a history of failure in traditional chemical dependency treatment programs. Many residents have mental health issues that contribute to the cycle of alcoholism.





GLENWOOD RESIDENCE 2013 AT A GLANCE

- Glenwood Residence houses 80 permanent residents
- Assisted approximately 100 chronic alcoholics; many also have mental health issues
- Eighty two percent of tenants retained their housing for six months
- Thirty five percent of tenants were 55-years-old and older


- Three meals served daily
