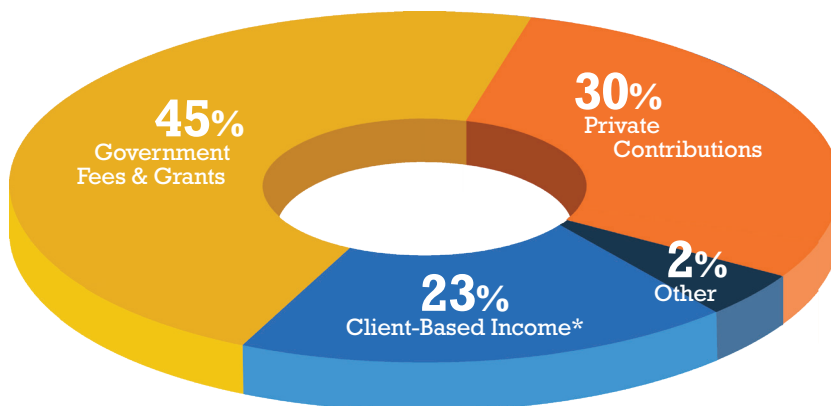


Community Trends

- From FY23 to FY24, Catholic Charities saw a 32% increase in the number of people served across our programs.
- The people we serve are struggling more than ever before: 2/3 report having a serious mental illness; 28% report having a serious substance use disorder; and 80% report having a major disability that "interferes with their ability to work or one or more activities of daily living."
- Older adult homelessness (age 55+) has risen 7% since 2018.

Our Financial Stewardship

Annual operating expense: \$61.5M. Major sources of revenue:



*Including program fees, Medicaid reimbursements, and government-based housing rents.)



Fundraising and Administrative expense is 15%, consistently well below the *Charities Review Council* standard of 35%.



Catholic Charities holds a 4-star rating from *Charity Navigator* signifying that a charity exceeds or meets best practices and industry standards across almost all areas.

Governance and Leadership

- Catholic Charities Twin Cities is an independent 501c3 nonprofit organization.
- As of January 1, 2025, our independent **Board of Directors includes 34 voting members** elected by executive committee and including an ex-officio representative of the Archdiocese; President/CEO and Archbishop are nonvoting members.
- **CEO Jamie Verbrugge joined Catholic Charities in January 2025.** As an infant, Jamie's adoption was facilitated by Catholic Charities, yielding a "lifelong affinity for the organization".



- Our dedicated team of **500+ employees** includes a wide variety of professions, from social workers and mental health consultants to program leaders and fundraising specialists.
